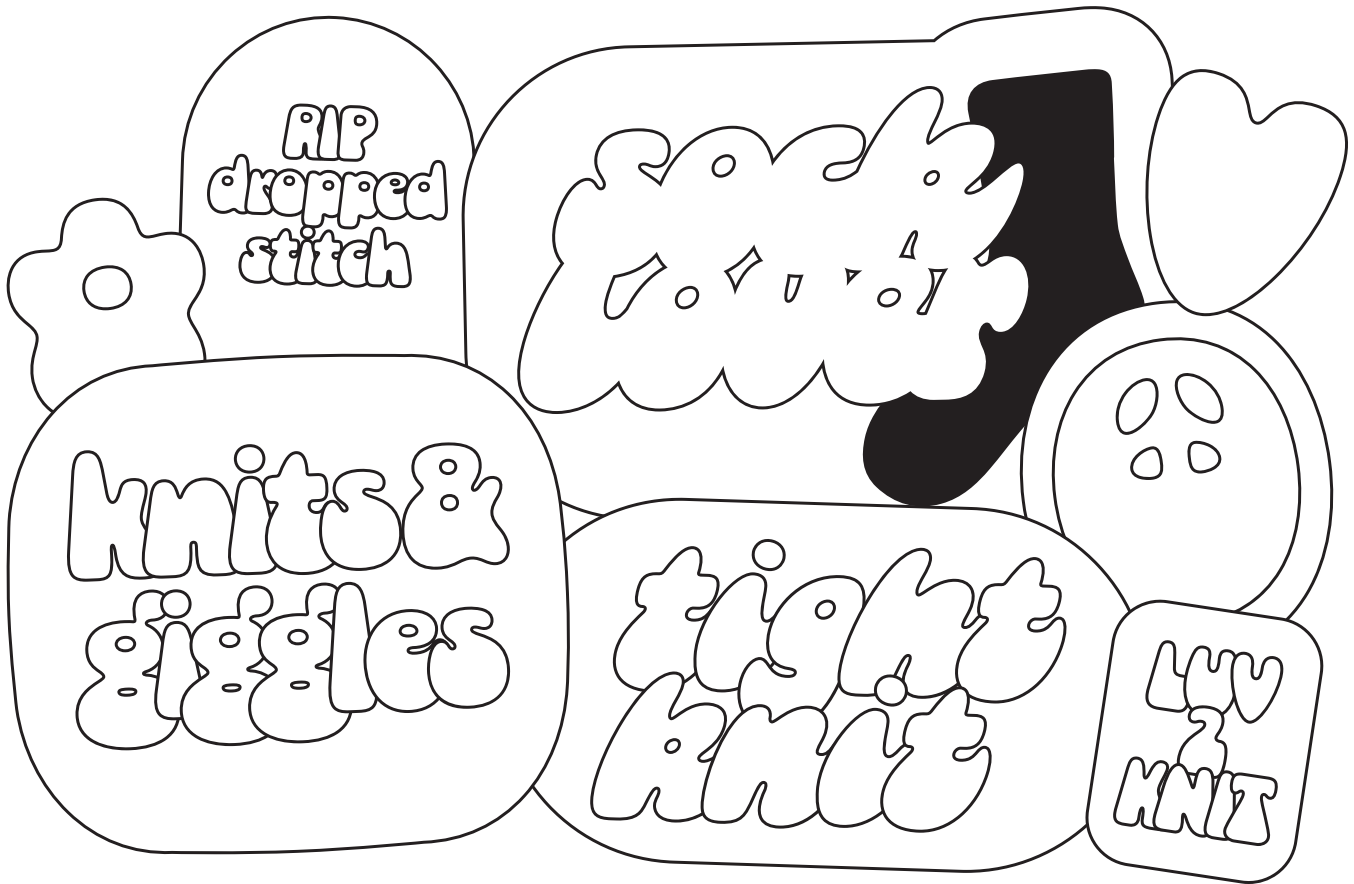

Regular 24pt / 25pt Line Height

A sock is a piece of clothing worn on the feet and often covering the ankle or some part of the calf. Some types of shoes or boots are typically worn over socks.

Italic 24pt / 25pt Line Height

In ancient times, socks were made from leather or matted animal hair. In the late 16th century, machine knit socks were first produced. Until the 1800s, both handmade and machine knit socks were manufactured, with the latter technique becoming more common in the 19th century, and continuing until the modern day.

Regular & Italic 16pt / 19pt Line Height

One of the roles of socks is *absorbing perspiration*. The foot is among the *heaviest* producers of sweat in the body, it can produce over 0.25 US pints (0.12 L) of perspiration *per day*; socks help to absorb this sweat and draw it to areas where air can *evaporate the perspiration*. They also protect shoes, a more expensive, durable, and frequently *re-worn* foot covering, from perspiration, extending their life.

In cold environments, socks made from cotton or wool help warm up cold feet which in turn helps *decrease* the risk of getting frostbite. Thin socks are most commonly worn in the summer months to keep feet cool.
